Display boards set up around the room shared information about why the tree and brush clearing is needed, what to expect, locations of the tree removals and future project planning. Project team attendees included representatives from Alberta Transportation and their consulting team.

The information session was advertised on eight road signs in communities adjacent to clearing areas, through the project email distribution list and on the project website (<u>westringroad.ca</u>).

Comment Summary

Fourteen comment forms were completed. Attendees expressed concerns over the extent of the tree clearing, the impacts on wildlife in the area and the potential impacts of the storm pond proposed in the southwest corner of the 17 Ave SW interchange on Pinebrook residents. Respondents were also looking for more information on plans for restoration and several mentioned sound attenuation would be needed in the absence of trees.
